

How do I turn on JavaScript in my browser?

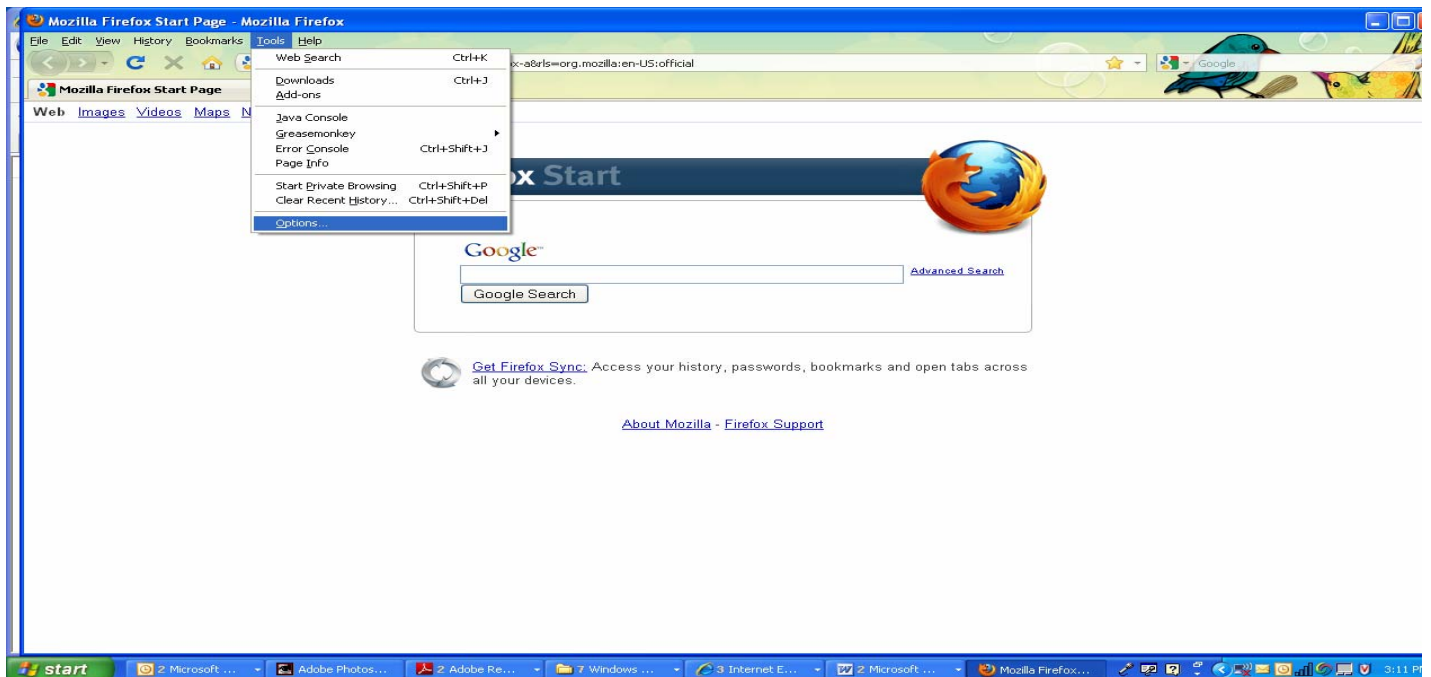
Browsers that support JavaScript® allow you to take advantage of advanced features on our website, including drop-down menus for easy navigation. If you have problems viewing the drop-down menus, you probably have JavaScript turned off in your browser, or your browser doesn't support JavaScript.

To turn on JavaScript, follow the directions below:

Mozilla Firefox 3.x (Windows)

1. Select **Options...** from the **Tools** drop-down menu.
2. Select the **Content** section from the options at the top of the pop-up page.
3. Check the “Block pop-up windows,” “Load images automatically,” and “Enable JavaScript” boxes.
4. Click **OK**.
